The IB Design Cycle

At Homestead Middle, the design cycle is applied to solve problems in a structured thought process. There are many different types of design cycles (often called a design process, or design thinking). The IB MYP Design Cycle follows the following four steps: Inquiring and Analyzing, Developing Ideas, Creating a Solution, and Evaluation. While these steps create a roadmap to follow when solving a problem (or completing a project in school), it is encouraged that these steps are revisited, and not completed in a linear order.
