# TRANSITION PLANNING FOR MILITARY FAMILIES

### **SCHOOL MILITARY POINT OF CONTACT**

### **GETTING STARTED**

We understand that military transitions for children include much more than school plans and enrollment. If you are transitioning to the Navy, Marine Reserve Center, Miami Recruiting Battalion, or U.S. Southern Command with school-age children, every address in our school district is served by a residentially zoned elementary school, one residentially zoned middle school, and one residentially zoned high school.

## **MILITARY FAMILIES**

### **ENROLLING IN M-DCPS**

Enrolling your child in our school system shouldn't be the toughest part of your transition to our area! Let us help you with a step-by-step guide!

- To begin, you may need to complete an "online enrollment application" if your child has never received public school services in Miami-Dade County Public Schools. If your child already exists in our school district's student information system, please DO NOT create an additional record. However, if your child does not already exist in our system, proceed to the online enrollment application to begin the process.
- Items you'll need to help you create a simple record of your child in the online enrollment application system are:
  - Emergency Contact Information
  - Health Insurance Information
  - Medical Information
- Documents you'll need to have with you to register at the school include:
  - Proof of Address (Any ONE of the following will suffice):
    - A current utility bill—either water, electricity, or gas (These are the most used proofs of residence.)
    - A copy of a signed lease or housing agreement. (If your family is staying with another family and consequently does not have proof of address, use the address verification form and attach one of the aforementioned proofs of residence to the notarized address verification form.)
    - If you reside in temporary housing (such as the Navy Lodge, etc.), please bring a copy of the most recent bill/invoice/receipt.
  - Recent Physical (within the past 12 months).
  - Current immunization records.
  - Verification of Age (most commonly, an authorized copy of the child's official birth certificate).
  - Social Security Number(if applicable).
  - State- or Government-Issued Photo ID of the parent/guardian enrolling the child.

### **ACADEMIC PROGRAMS**

Homestead Middle School offers a rigorous and engaging curriculum that supports critical thinking, creativity, and personal growth. Through the International Baccalaureate (IB) Middle Years Programme (MYP), students engage in challenging coursework, earn up to five high school credits, and study a second language in Spanish or French.

Our school is also home to the Verizon Innovative Learning Lab, a state-of-the-art facility that provides access to advanced computers, virtual reality, coding, robotics, and multimedia tools, preparing students with skills for the digital future.

In addition, students have opportunities to explore diverse subjects such as Agriscience, Music, Art, Theater, Mindfulness, Multimedia/Podcasting, and to participate in leadership and enrichment activities through Student Government and the National Junior Honor Society

### AMBASSADOR/PEER SUPPORT PROGRAM



## **MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES**

#### **MENTAL HEALTH CHALLENGES**

Positive mental wellness is essential to a child's healthy development. School and community mental health services can improve academics, provide access to building social skills, promote leadership, increase self-awareness, and help children make caring connections in school and the community.

Military-connected students face unique challenges, including extended parental deployments, frequent school transitions, and leaving behind friends. These experiences can impact their academic and emotional well-being. To support your child during these times, the school's Student Services staff— such as the School Counselor, Mental Health Coordinator, School Psychologist, and School Social Worker—are available to offer assistance and provide resources to ensure that military-connected students and their families receive comprehensive care and support.. They can help your child navigate the emotional and social difficulties associated with these challenges.

Additionally, families are encouraged to explore the Miami-Dade County Public Schools <u>Student Services website</u> and <u>Mental Health website</u> for further support, which includes tools and resources tailored to the needs of all families.
